AAPM&R's Registry collects high-quality, clinician and patient data across independent physician practices and larger institutions for use in generating insights to inform best practices, guide pioneering research and improve patient care. Currently, the Registry has two programs centered on ischemic stroke and low back pain, two critical areas that most physiatrists treat. The Registry will expand data collection efforts to other clinical areas in the future.
