

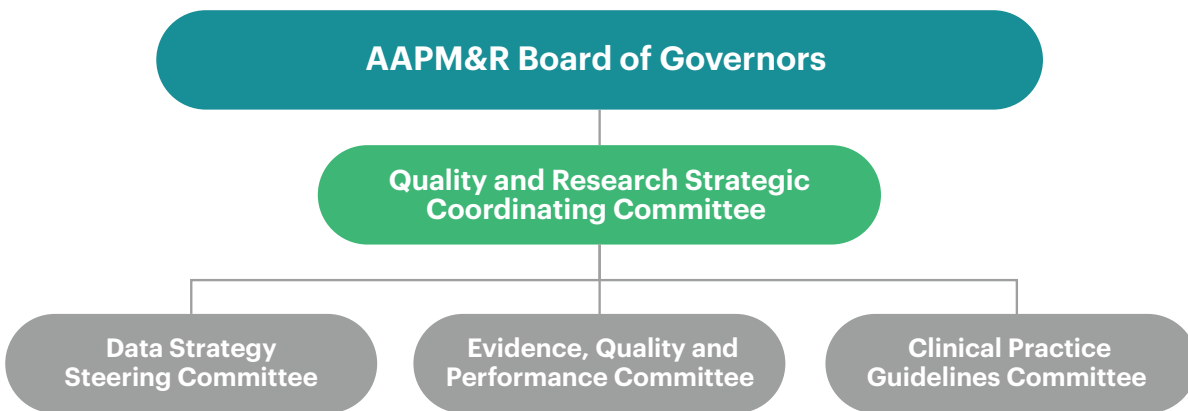
AAPM&R Quality and Research: Empowering and Guiding PM&R
