Scoring:

- Response Levels: 1=No; 3=Somewhat; 5=Yes; N/A=Not Applicable
- **These items require a score of at least 4 or N/A- If they do not, participation requirements will not be met.
- Total must meet minimum scoring of 26 (75%) for participation Includes both individual scores and group averages.
