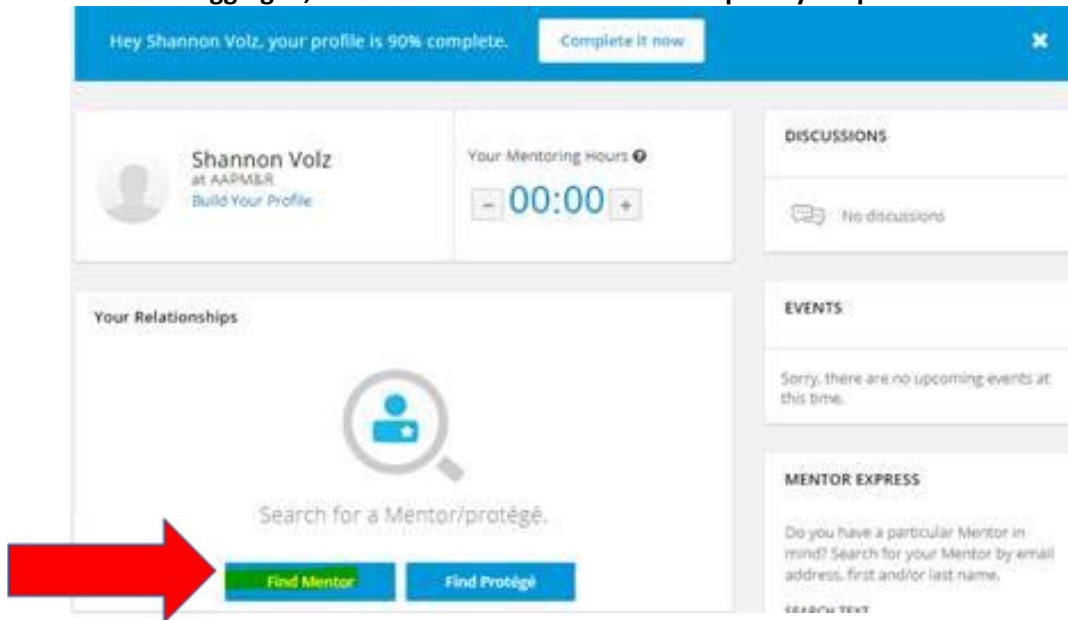
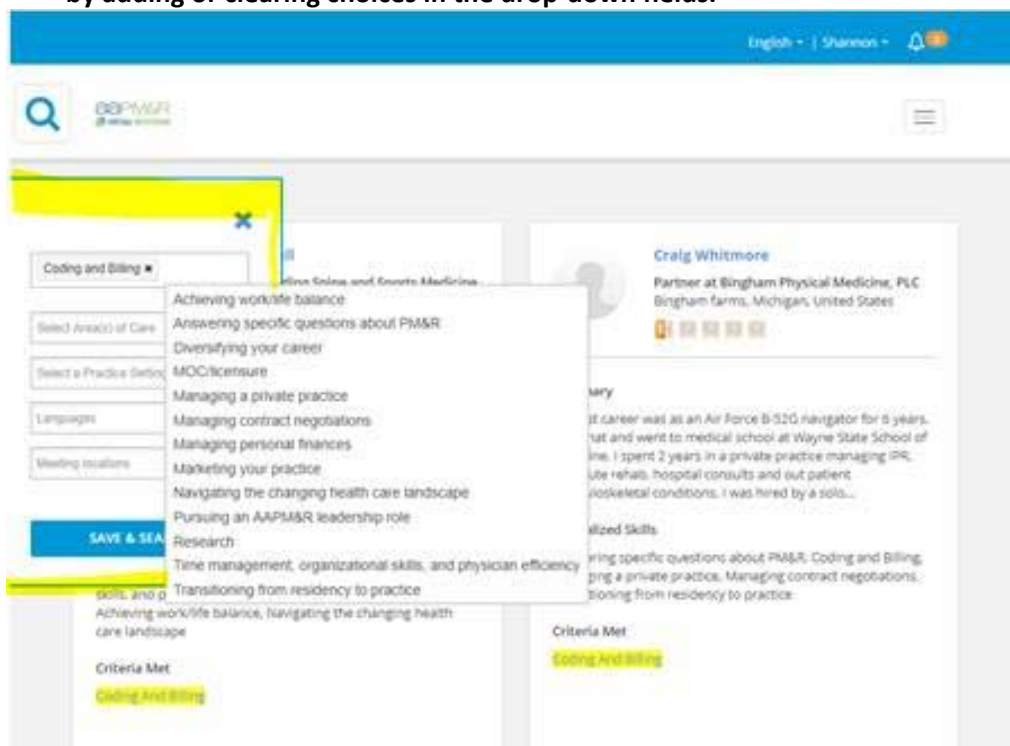


1. After logging in, click Find Mentor. Be sure to complete your profile first.
